

The wonderful thing about Keller-Jenny's memoir, her writing and the editors compilation is that this is not a blind devotee of Jung, his students and the training. Keller-Jenny makes clear the gender-bias that was a part of her own marriage, Jung's marriage, how he treated his female students and analysts and the societal limitations that Keller-Jenny persevered through to become a respected doctor and analyst, all the while a mother and wife and student.
